

## Patient Billing Policy

After the results of the Apifyny<sup>®</sup> test have been returned to the ordering clinician, patient billing will be handled as follows:

### Patients with Commercial Insurance and Medicare Advantage Insurance:

- Armune will bill the patient's insurance company for the Apifyny test.
- After a claim has been submitted, the patient may receive an Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from the insurance company. **The Explanation of Benefits is NOT A BILL.** The purpose of the EOB is to explain what medical services were covered and what may be a patient's financial responsibility for the test.
- After processing insurance reimbursement, the patient may have some financial responsibility in the form of a co-pay, co-insurance or deductible amount, determined by the patient's insurance company. Armune will bill the patient for any out-of-pocket share of covered services that is designated by the insurance company. Armune provides for a convenient payment for out-of-pocket costs using check or debit/credit card.
- If any insurance company denies payment for the claim, Armune will file an appeal on the patient's behalf. Armune may ask the patient or the provider for support in the appeal process. The appeal process may take several months to complete.

### Patients selecting the "Self-Pay" option:

- If the patient indicates 'Patient Self-Pay' on the **Apifyny Test Requisition Form**, Armune will send an invoice to the patient when results are reported to the ordering clinician.
- **Apifyny Self-pay price: \$350.00**

### Medicare Patients:

- Armune continues to work with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to secure reimbursement for the Apifyny test. Until we secure a coverage decision from CMS, Armune will continue to advise patients of likely non-coverage of the Apifyny<sup>®</sup> test and will notify patients using the **Advance Beneficiary Notice of Non-coverage (ABN)**.
