

Apifiny® Test Directory

Overview	Apifiny is a blood test that measures the body's immune response to cancerous activity in prostate tissue. Apifiny is designed to aid in the risk assessment of prostate cancer and in the selection of patients for biopsy. The Apifiny test result is reported as a score that indicates a potential risk of having prostate cancer.
Reference Range	0-100. Scores below 59 are considered lower relative risk, scores at or above 59 higher relative risk.
Methodology	Immunoassay, flow cytometry, algorithmic analysis

Reported	3 - 5 business days

Unacceptable Conditions	Improper sample ID, storage, or shipment. Refer to Apifiny User Guide for list of rejection criteria.
